Holton, Taxolog is dedicated to the research, development, clinical testing and commercialization of new drugs for the treatment of cancer and other diseases. The company concentrates its efforts on the advancement of cures based on new and exciting pharmacologically powerful drugs, the taxanes.

Taxolog's initial research and development focus has been to design drugs that treat tumors exhibiting drug resistance and tumors for which there is no effective therapy, such as cancers of the lung, colon, prostate, breast, pancreas and skin. Additionally, the taxanes have shown promise in the treatment of several non-cancer chronic diseases. Programs are also underway to determine the efficacy of relatively non-toxic analogs against diseases such as Alzheimer's Disease, Polycystic Kidney Disease and Rheumatoid Arthritis.

Recently, Taxolog, Inc., opened a new biomedical research facility – complete with laboratories and office space – in Tallahassee, Florida. Taxolog's New Jersey facility will continue chemical research of taxanes, while the Florida operation will handle biological development.
